SUMMER READING PROGRAM GUIDELINES

- Registration for the Summer Reading Program begins as soon as we visit your child's school or June 4th at the library. You will receive your reading log and a free book just for registering.
- Read on your own or have someone read to you.
- On the reading log there are 6 levels. To complete a level you must read 20 minutes to fill in a picture and fill in all 10 pictures. Once the level is complete you may move on to the next level.
- You can turn in one level or multiple levels at a time.
- All levels must be completed and turned in by July 27th to receive a prize, be entered into the grand prize drawing, and get an invitation to a party on August 2nd.
- New this year we have a raffle for participants who complete 5 of the 8 activities on the bottom of the reading log. This will be an entry to a special prize. This also must be completed and turned in by July 27th.
- Children can continue to earn coupons to local restaurants until August 31st by completing additional reading levels.
